We listen to your individual needs and wishes to develop a roster where qualified support staff work with you to achieve your goals.

Our focus is on supporting you to undertake these tasks so you can become as independent as possible.

**HomePlace is a registered provider of support with the NDIS.**

This means that if you have an approved NDIS plan, you can use HomePlace for any of the services we offer that are listed in your plan.

**Our NDIS-approved support services include:**

- Assistance with daily personal activities
- Assistance with daily life tasks in a shared living arrangement
- Help with household tasks
- Training for independence in transport, life skills and independent living
- Assistance to integrate into educational programs or day activities
- Assistance with travel/transport arrangements
- Participation in community and social activities
- Accommodation/tenancy assistance
