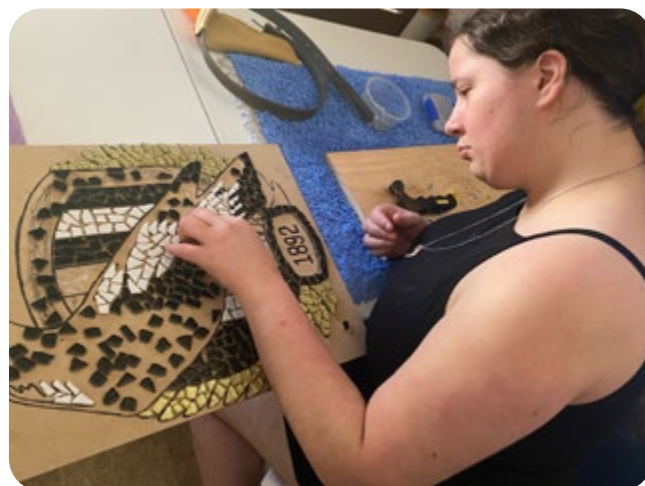
Happy Birthday, Julie!

Adventures with Jackie & Kobi

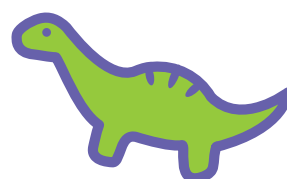
Right: Jackie had two lovely celebrations for her birthday, one at a cafe and another with her parents.
